
Dedication Ceremony February 10, 1996



CAVITT HOUSE

ATTORNEY WILLIAM R. CAVITT (1849-1924) PURCHASED A CITY BLOCK HERE IN 1875, THE YEAR HE MARRIED MARY MITCHELL. CAVITT BECAME BRAZOS COUNTY ATTORNEY IN 1878 AND ABOUT 1880 HE AND MARY BUILT A BRICK ITALIANATE RESIDENCE HERE. CAVITT LATER SERVED AS A STATE LEGISLATOR AND ON THE BOARD OF TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY. THE CAVITTS MODIFIED THE HOUSE IN THE 1920S TO REFLECT CONTEMPORARY COLONIAL REVIVAL INFLUENCES. THE HOUSE REMAINED IN THE CAVITT FAMILY UNTIL 1978.
